The Return of Self-registration to PANORAMIC

The PANORAMIC database team are working to reintroduce self-registration to the PANORAMIC website in the coming days. The registration model is set out below by region:

- In **Northern Ireland and Scotland**, potential participants will register online and then be followed-up by the relevant hub.
- In **England** those registering online will be either directed to a local hub or recruited by the Central Team.
- In **Wales**, potential participants will be either recruited locally or under a forthcoming centralised model.

SAE Reporting and Casualty Assessment

Where hub teams are first aware of a SAE, they must within 24-hours complete the SAE CRF and the PI or delegate must provide an assessment of causality. Where the PI or delegate is unavailable to provide that assessment of causality within that 24-hour period, the reporter of the SAE must alert the Central Team ASAP using these contact details:
