

Positive Participant feedback

During four- and six-month follow ups our central Calls Team are often the first to hear participants' reflections on their progress through the trial. Participants report their sense of pride at having contributed to the trial and for their 'chance to give something back.' It is during these moments that the Calls Team also hear of participants' gratitude to their respective recruiting hubs, with participants saying thank you for hubs' 'professionalism, care and kindness', their 'support when I was ill and frightened', and how during those times teams had 'really reassured and comforted me'. You are much appreciated!

Weekly Recruitment Target

With central and hub recruitment now supported by self-registration, PANORAMIC expects to reach its target of recruiting a minimum of 210 participants each week, towards a total of 3,000-5,000 by March 2023. Under this plan, the central team have the capacity to recruit up to 150 participants per week and the hubs (between them) should recruit 60 or more participants per week. This equates to 2 per hub per week, given that our current number of active hubs is 32.



Hubs, Spokes & ICFs

When **hub** teams recruit participants who are registered patients of the hub's spokes, please ensure spokes are informed of the participant's participation in the trial and provide a copy of the **Informed Consent Form** for the participant's medical records.

Spinnaker Glitches, Fixes, and Know-how

Please report any Spinnaker issues to the PANORAMIC email as we can often resolve them on the spot. What's more, we follow up every report with the database developers, Spiral, in our bi-weekly catchups. For bigger glitches, Spiral can often implement hot fixes - So help us help you by letting us know when you have a problem.

Useful know-how tips include:

- 1. Users can only log into their account simultaneously from one device at a time.
- 2. When Spinnaker times out after 40 minutes of disuse, all Spinnaker tabs open for that user will also log out.
- 3. If you are unable to enter data in the next section of a CRF it is often due to an earlier unfilled field.
- New to Spinnaker and experiencing problems? Try logging-in via a different browser and avoid Firefox.
- 5. And lastly, the universal fix of turning it off and on again can often resolve issues with devices!
